Our pastor recommended that I attend the Dennis Brown Memorial Home Mission Conference the next week at First Baptist Church, Englewood, CO while Sandy went to meet our new grandson in Rapid City, SD. On Friday March 2nd as we were travelling to the Revival meeting in Stratford, TX we received a phone call from Pastor Clifton Mizer concerning our need. Bro. Mizer lifted our spirits by telling me that they would present our need at the Conference and help us fix our truck! We stopped and spent time in prayer to thank the Lord for this encouragement. Not only were the messages of the Conference what I needed but \$10,000 was raised for our truck! We are still rejoicing and humbled at God's provision for us. I am thrilled to report to you that God continued to provide funds through His churches in addition to what was raised at the Home Mission Conference. On March 26th we were able to pay the whole amount of \$14,377.50 and drive away in our repaired truck! Hallelujah! Words alone cannot express our appreciation to all who prayed for us and those who gave to our need! I am still working on writing my Thank you cards (there were so many).

God's word holds many promises that we are still discovering and putting into practice in our lives. We are constantly reminded of the goodness of our Heavenly Father and His promise *“Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.”*

Please continue to pray for us as we break in the new motor travelling down the trails of America preaching and singing in meetings God has provided for us. We are grateful for your continued prayer support.
