Greetings in this New Year God has given us! 2016 was an amazing year of trials and blessings and it. We face this year with anticipation as we embark upon this opportunity to sail into great waters! It is an honor to serve our Heavenly Father! He is the one who chart the waters He wants us to sail.

That will cost us about \$2,000 and then we will be good to go. We had to replace an EGR Temperature Sensor a couple of weeks ago which, Praise the Lord, cost us under \$300.00.

I have included the pictures of the truck before the rescue and pictures after we pulled the cosmetics off. We are excited about God’s blessings. We are currently trying to sell the 2004 and ask you to pray for it to sell so that money can go onto the principal of our “new” truck.

We are currently in Southern Arizona. We were in Arivaca and Amado a week ago and Coolidge this past weekend. God has blessed with one woman saved and some assurances of salvation, as well as some personal commitments made for the Lord. We are looking forward to the Meetings and services God has given us this month and next before we head back to Texas for a Revival in Stratford. Then we travel down the trail to Colorado, Kansas, Missouri, Ohio and North Carolina by the middle of April. These are exciting Times to serve the Lord!
