Dear Friends,

It is hard to believe we have entered the third month of the year already! As this year unveiled, we didn't know what God had for us to experience. Sandy had been experiencing shortness of breath, a huge problem of water retention as well as exhaustion. She contributed it to being related to her having Covid last Spring. As it turned out she was in heart failure stemming from severe anemia. It was really bad and honestly we came very close to losing her if it hadn't been for our Nurse Practitioner Daughters telling us to get her to the hospital! When we arrived at Fairhaven Baptist Church, Coolidge, AZ we set up our camper and headed to the ER. They began giving her units of blood (5 total) and in 2 days she had a loss of 40 lbs of fluids. Over the course of her hospitalization for 9 days the team performed many procedures to find a source of bleeding to explain anemia. While they did not find a smoking gun, they ruled out active bleeding. She is continually getting stronger and regaining her energy. When we went to her Cardiologist on February 9th, the Dr. was pleased with her progress. Sandy asked about some knots moving up her leg and following the Ultrasound it was discovered she had blood clots. The Dr. prescribed Eloquis (blood thinner) and she is on it until her appointment in Scottsdale May 19th (we will fly back to see the Cardiologist and GI Dr).

Here is a note from Sandy: *I asked my hubby if I could write a paragraph in our prayer letter, and he got so excited, he wanted to give me the whole letter! He is not the writer of the family! And I do love writing. With all my heart, I wanted to thank each of those who have prayed especially for me during this time, when my health hung in the balance. Because of your prayers, God gave me the best doctors, nurses, and hospital stay. In no time, they knew what they were dealing with, how to find the problem, and what to do about it. But you took me before the throne of God with the most excellent gift of prayer, and I treasure it. Thank you all! Thank you so much. I have no doubt that those prayers are why I am so much better. And again, thank you! “I rejoice at thy word, as one that findeth great spoil.” Psalm 119:62 What great spoil (treasure) your prayers have been to me! God bless and keep you!*

We thank you for your prayers during this ordeal and ask you to continue to pray for Sandy's health and my trying to keep her from overdoing things. We are in Colorado for this month and then on down the Trail. We also want to say Thank You to those who continue to check on Sandy's progress as well as those who have sent offerings to help with what Medicare A did not cover. Thank you for your kind gifts!
